

Feature Updates are delivered into a new "Feature Channel"

- · Customer must be current on the latest support pack and patch channel updates before applying
- · Feature Channel is optional, but if subscribed to, customer should update to all updates in the channel
- (n-1) support still exists at support pack level, ("n" meaning latest support pack), SPs do not go away
- All Feature Updates in the Feature Channel are rolled into the next Support Pack
